**BACKGROUND:**

The attached DPAP memorandum of 17 August 2010 authorized a class deviation from DFARS 242.803(b)(i)(C), which eases the requirements for contractors, especially small contractors, to qualify for direct submission of interim vouchers for provisional payments. The deviation reduces DoD administration and conserves resources in processing low risk payment vouchers.

**POLICY:**

- a. Effective immediately, this class deviation deletes the words "for contractors with approved billing systems" from DFARS 242.803(b)(i)(C).
- b. This class deviation is effective immediately and will remain in effect until it is incorporated into the DFARS or otherwise rescinded.

**PROCEDURES:**

Contracting Officers shall ensure that all MCFCS contracts are reviewed for a determination of the applicability of DFARS 242.803(b)(i)(C) and affected contractors notified of the deviation which eases the requirements for direct submission of interim vouchers.


