RMKS/1. SITUATION. THIS MESSAGE ANNOUNCES U.S. MARINE CORPS DISTRIBUTION MANAGEMENT INTERMEDIATE COURSE CLASS DATES FOR FY15.

2. DISTRIBUTION MANAGEMENT INTERMEDIATE COURSE (DMIC) CLASS CID M030111.

A. DMIC IS A 15 DAY TRAINING COURSE THAT PROVIDES INTERMEDIATE LEVEL TRAINING TO BRIDGE THE GAP BETWEEN ENLISTED ENTRY LEVEL TRAINING AND DISTRIBUTION OPERATIONS WHILE IN A GARRISON, DEPLOYED OR COMBAT ENVIRONMENT. THIS CLASS IS INTENDED FOR MARINE CORPS NCO'S (CPL-SGT) IN THE 3112 MOS.

B. FUNDED ALLOCATIONS. THE COURSE REQUIRES THE PARENT UNIT TO FUND ALL TO/FROM TRAVEL, LODGING, AND PER DIEM COSTS FOR STUDENTS.

4. STUDENTS WILL REPORT TO BUILDING M79 DURING WORKING HOURS. AFTER WORKING HOURS STUDENTS WILL REPORT TO THE AREA OFFICER OF THE DAY (AOOD) IN BUILDING M131. STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO CHECK IN WEARING THE SERVICE 'A' UNIFORM. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BRING

APPROPRIATE SEASONAL MARINE CORPS COMBAT UTILITY UNIFORM (MCCUU), SEASONAL SERVICE ('B' OR 'C') UNIFORM, AND PT GEAR (GREEN ON GREEN WITH GLOW BELT). ALL NON-LOCAL NCO'S WILL RESIDE IN THE HEADQUARTERS AND SERVICE BARRACKS.
