1. PURPOSE. THIS MESSAGE ANNOUNCES CY15 MARINE CORPS LOGISTICS TRAINING AND EDUCATION

2. INTERMEDIATE MAGTF LOGISTICS OPERATIONS COURSE (IMLOC) (CID: M09F2F9). IMLOC  
PROVIDES CRITICAL BILLET ENHANCEMENT TRAINING FOR OFFICERS AND STAFF NONCOMMISSIONED  
OFFICERS SERVING, OR SLATED FOR ASSIGNMENT, AS UNIT OPERATIONS OFFICERS OR CHIEFS  
WITHIN THE LOGISTICS COMBAT ELEMENT AND GROUND LOGISTICS UNITS/SECTIONS AT THE  
BATTALION AND REGIMENTAL LEVEL, OR AS STAFF LOGISTICS OFFICERS/CHIEFS ABOVE THE  
BATTALION AND SQUADRON LEVEL. IMLOC IS A 35 TRAINING DAY COURSE CONDUCTED BY MARINE  
CORPS LOGISTICS OPERATIONS GROUP (MCLOG) AND IS HELD ABOARD MARINE CORPS AIR GROUND  
COMBAT CENTER (MCAGCC), TWENTYNINE PALMS, CALIFORNIA. THE COURSE PROVIDES INSTRUCTION  
COVERING 2000 LEVEL TRAINING AND READINESS (T&R) EVENTS FOR CSS OFFICERS AND  
SNCOS. TARGET STUDENT POPULATION FOR IMLOC IS 0402/1302/3002 MAJORS AND  
04XX/13XX/30XX/35XX MASTER SERGEANTS AND MASTER GUNNERY SERGEANTS. CAPTAINS AND

THIS COURSE IS DESIGNED FOR OFFICERS IN GRADES O-4 THROUGH O-6, WARRANT OFFICERS IN GRADES CWO-3 THROUGH CWO-5, ENLISTED IN GRADES E-7 THROUGH E-9, AND DOD CIVILIANS GS-13 THROUGH GS-15 WHO ARE MID-TO-SENIOR LEVEL LOGISTICS MANAGERS. TO ACCOMPLISH THESE GOALS, THIS SEMINAR ADDRESSES THE CHALLENGES OF IMPLEMENTING STABILITY OPERATIONS IN POST-CRISIS STATES, INCLUDING HUMANITARIAN RELIEF, SECURITY, GOVERNANCE, AND ECONOMIC RECOVERY TO AREAS AFFECTED BY MANMADE OR NATURAL DISASTERS OR CONFLICT. THIS COURSE FOCUSES ON CURRENT FLEET TRENDS AND TECHNICAL DEVELOPMENTS WHILE IT ALSO STRESSES DEVELOPING EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT MANAGERIAL SKILLS TO MEET THE CHALLENGING "AT SEA" ENVIRONMENT. THIS PROGRAM IS DESIGNED FOR OFFICERS IN GRADES O-2 THROUGH O-4, WARRANT OFFICERS IN GRADES CWO-3 THROUGH CWO-5, ENLISTED IN GRADES E-7 THROUGH E-9, AND DOD CIVILIANS GS-12 THROUGH GS-13 (GS-11 BY EXCEPTION). 10. INTRODUCTION TO EXPEDITIONARY LOGISTICS (IEL)

A. DESCRIPTION. THE NAVY SUPPLY CORPS SCHOOL WILL CONDUCT IEL AT NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND. THIS COURSE IS TAUGHT AS A SEMINAR WITH GUEST SPEAKERS AS SUBJECT MATTER EXPERTS. INTRODUCTION TO EXPEDITIONARY LOGISTICS IS BOTH A TWO-WEEK RESIDENT COURSE AND AN EXPORTABLE, TWO-DAY COURSE DESIGN. THE STUDENTS WILL, THROUGH THE USE OF THE SEMINAR DISCUSSIONS AND A FINAL GROUP EXERCISE INVOLVING A LOGISTICS SCENARIO,
