NARR/REF (A) ISSUED DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE (DOD) POLICY REQUIRING NEW IDENTITY SCREENING PROCEDURES OF SPACE-AVAILABLE PASSENGERS TRAVELING ON DOD OWNED AND CONTRACTED AIRCRAFT. REF (B) PRESCRIBES PROCEDURAL GUIDANCE FOR PASSENGER IDENTITY SCREENING ON DOD OWNED/CONTROLLED AIRCRAFT. REF (C) IDENTIFIES THE DIFFERENT CATEGORIES OF PERSONNEL WHO ARE AUTHORIZED TO OCCUPY DOD AIRCRAFT SEATS THAT ARE SURPLUS AFTER ALL SPACE-REQUIRED PASSENGERS HAVE BEEN ACCOMODATED. REF (D) PUBLISHES REVISED POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF MARINE CORPS SPONSORED PERSONNEL.//

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GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. SITUATION.

1.A. PURPOSE. THIS MARADMIN PROMULGATES THE NEW SPACE-AVAILABLE PASSENGER SCREENING POLICY OUTLINED IN REF (A).

2. MISSION. TO ENSURE MARINE CORPS SPONSORED PERSONNEL TRAVELING ON SPACE-AVAILABLE TRANSPORTATION ARE AWARE OF AND UNDERSTAND UPDATED POLICY AND PROCEDURES CONCERNING NEW PASSENGER IDENTITY SCREENING REQUIREMENTS.

3. EXECUTION.

3.A. CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS.

3.A.1. EFFECTIVE ON OR ABOUT 7 MARCH, 2014, ALL SPACE-AVAILABLE TRAVELERS WILL BE SCREENED AGAINST SEVERAL U.S. GOVERNMENT WATCH LISTS, INCLUDING THE NO-FLY LIST, BY USING THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (DHS) TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION (TSA) SECURE FLIGHT PROGRAM. TO ENSURE MARINE CORPS AND ALL OTHER DOD SPONSORED PERSONNEL TRAVELING ON DOD-OWNED AND DOD CONTRACTED AIRCRAFT ARE AFFORDED EFFECTIVE AVIATION SECURITY SAFEGUARDS, PASSENGER MANIFEST GENERATING LOCATIONS, INCLUDING MARINE CORPS PASSENGER TERMINALS LOCATED AT MARINE CORPS AIR STATIONS, WILL ENSURE THAT ALL SPACE-AVAILABLE PASSENGERS UNDERGO MANDATORY IDENTITY SCREENING PRIOR TO BOARDING AIRCRAFT.

3.A.2. MANDATORY SPACE-AVAILABLE PASSENGER IDENTITY SCREENING SUPPLEMENTS, BUT DOES NOT REPLACE, PHYSICAL AND BAGGAGE SECURITY

SCREENING REQUIREMENTS.

4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS.

4.A. LOGISTICS:

4.A.1. MARINE CORPS AND ALL OTHER DOD SPONSORED PERSONNEL DESIRING SPACE-AVAILABLE TRANSPORTATION WHO ARE BOARDED AT MARINE CORPS INSTALLATIONS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PASSENGER IDENTITY SCREENING INFORMATION IMMEDIATELY UPON REQUEST TO THE DOD PASSENGER SERVICE AGENT (PSA) BUT NOT LATER THAN NINETY (90) MINUTES PRIOR TO SCHEDULED DEPARTURE. MARINE CORPS AND ALL OTHER DOD SPONSORED PERSONNEL WHO ARRIVE AT PASSENGER TERMINALS WITH LESS THAN NINETY (90) MINUTES PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED DEPARTURE TIME MAY BE SUBJECT TO SECURITY SCREENING DELAYS THAT POTENTIALLY RESULT IN INELIGIBILITY FOR THE SPACE AVAILABLE TRANSPORTATION.

4.A.2. WHEN USING A PASSPORT FOR OCONUS TRAVEL, MARINE CORPS AND ALL OTHER DOD SPONSORED PERSONNEL MUST ALSO PRESENT THEIR PASSPORT FOR SCREENING.
