GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. PURPOSE. TO ANNOUNCE THE 2015 LOG COAG, TO BE HELD 27 - 29 OCT 2015 IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION (NCR). CHAIRED BY THE ASSISTANT DEPUTY COMMANDANT, LOGISTICS PLANS, POLICIES, AND STRATEGIC MOBILITY DIVISION [ADC, I&L (LP)] , THE LOG COAG IS CHARTERED AS AN OFFICIAL FORUM TO BETTER ALIGN RESOURCES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR LOGISTICS RELATED ISSUES SUPPORTING REF A ACROSS THE MARINE CORPS LOGISTICS ENTERPRISE WHILE SERVING IN AN ADVISORY CAPACITY TO THE DEPUTY COMMANDANT FOR INSTALLATIONS AND LOGISTICS (DC, I&L). THE LOG COAG WILL REVIEW AND PRIORITIZE LOGISTICS ISSUES THAT WILL THEN BE PRESENTED TO THE MAGTF LOGISTICS BOARD, SCHEDULED FOR 18 NOV 2015 IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION.
