GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. PURPOSE. THIS MESSAGE ANNOUNCES THE DC I&L 2015

T&D OAG TO BE HELD 23-26 MAR 2015 IN ALBANY, GA.

2. BACKGROUND. THE MISSION OF THE T&D OAG IS TO IMPROVE THE EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF MARINE CORPS TRANSPORTATION AND

DISTRIBUTION OPERATIONS. THE T&D OAG SERVES AS A VEHICLE TO IDENTIFY

AND PRIORITIZE ISSUES IMPACTING PROGRAMS SUPPORTING THE MARINE AIR GROUND TASK FORCE (MAGTF) AT THE STRATEGIC, OPERATIONAL, AND TACTICAL DISTRIBUTION LEVELS FOR RESOLUTION.

3. FOCUS. THE OAG WILL FOCUS ON ISSUES RELEVANT TO MAGTF LOGISTICS SUCH AS SUSTAINMENT DISTRIBUTION FROM POINT OF ORIGIN TO POINT OF EMPLOYMENT, DEPLOYMENT PHASE REQUIREMENTS, AND TRANSPORTATION IN SUPPORT OF TACTICAL DISTRIBUTION. IN ADDITION, PERSONNEL STRUCTURE, EQUIPMENT, FACILITIES, TRAINING, SAFETY, READINESS, AND STANDARDIZATION WITHIN ASSOCIATED COMMUNITIES OF INTEREST (COI) WILL BE ADDRESSED. ISSUES IDENTIFIED BY THE INTEGRATED LOGISTICS BOARD (ILB) AND/OR MAGTF LOGISTICS BOARD (MLB) IN 2014 WILL BE ADDRESSED. ISSUES BROUGHT FORWARD BY VOTING MEMBERS AND SUBJECT MATTER EXPERTS (SME) ATTENDING WILL BE DISCUSSED AND APPROPRIATE ACTIONS DETERMINED BY THE OAG. THE OAG WILL ANALYZE ISSUES AND FURTHER DEVELOP TASKS WITH THE INTENT TO RESOLVE THEM, OR PRESENT THEM FOR DECISION TO THE CONSOLIDATED OPERATIONS ADVISORY GROUP (COAG) AND/OR MLB FOR DECISION.

3.A. THE OAG WILL FOCUS ON THREE ISSUES IDENTIFIED BY THE MLB AND TOP TWO ISSUES IDENTIFIED BY THE FIVE WORKING GROUPS (WG) UNDER THE T&D OAG. THE WORKING GROUPS AND MLB ISSUES ARE:

3.A.1. DISTRIBUTION MANAGEMENT WORKING GROUP (MOS 31XX).

3.A.2. MOTOR TRANSPORT WORKING GROUP (MOS 35XX).

3.A.3. MOBILITY WORKING GROUP (MOS 0430).

3.A.4. IN-TRANSIT VISIBILITY WORKING GROUP (ITV).

3.A.5. MARINE CORPS CONTAINER WORKING GROUP (MCCWG).

3.A.6. MLB ISSUE ONE: DISTRIBUTION MANAGEMENT PROOF OF PRINCIPLE (POP) (11, 15, AND 24 MEU) IS TASKED TO THE DISTRIBUTION MANAGEMENT WORKING GROUP.

3.A.7. MLB ISSUE TWO: MARITIME PRE-POSITIONED FORCE DISTRIBUTION AND ACCOUNTABILITY TOTAL ASSET VISIBILITY (TAV) GAP ANALYSIS IS TASKED TO THE ITV WORKING GROUP.

3.A.8. MLB ISSUE THREE: MOTOR TRANSPORTATION STRUCTURE STUDY IS TASKED TO THE MOTOR TRANSPORT WORKING GROUP.

4. OAG AGENDA: THE OAG WILL CONVENE AT 0800 EACH DAY. A DETAILED AGENDA WITH BRIEFING TOPICS, REFERENCE MATERIALS, AND TIMES WILL BE POSTED ON THE DC I&L OAG SHAREPOINT WEBSITE PRIOR TO THE T&D OAG CONVENING DATE.

4.B. OPFOR INITIATED AGENDA ITEMS ARE ENCOURAGED; PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE WG POINTS OF CONTACT LISTED ON THIS MESSAGE.

4.C. DAY ONE (23 MAR 15): OAG MEMBERS WILL BREAK-UP INTO MOS WG'S (DMO, MOTOR TRANSPORT, MOBILITY) TO DISCUSS WHAT IS WORKING AND WHAT IS NOT WITHIN EACH OF THEIR COMMUNITIES IN TERMS OF CAPABILITIES AND CAPACITIES. MOS WG'S WILL PRIORITIZE THE IDENTIFIED ISSUES IN ORDER TO DEVELOP SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS, IDENTIFY DELIVERABLES, AND RECOMMEND ASSOCIATED POA&MS. DISCUSSION WILL ALSO INCLUDE ANY OTHER TOPICS OF RELEVANCE.

4.D. DAY TWO (24 MAR 15): THE ITV WG AND MCCWG WILL MEET IN ORDER TO PROVIDE BRIEFS, WORK PRIORITIZED ISSUES AND DEVELOP THE POA&MS AND DELIVERABLES. THROUGHOUT THE DAY SPECIFIC MEMBERS OF MOS WG'S MAY BE REQUIRED TO HOLD MINI-BREAKOUT SESSIONS TO CONTINUE DISCUSSION ON MOS WG OR MLB ISSUES.

4.E. DAY THREE (25 MAR 15): ATTENDEES WILL BE PROVIDED A LOGCOM 101 BRIEF AND A TOUR OF THE LOGCOM DISTRIBUTION MANAGEMENT CENTER (DMC) OPERATIONS CELL. THE GROUP WILL RECEIVE A DEMONSTRATION OF THE ENHANCED YARD MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (EYM) USED BY THE LOGCOM DMC. AN INFORMAL MIXER WILL BE HELD AT THE OFFICERS CLUB UPON THE CONCLUSION OF THE TOUR AND ALL BRIEFS.

4.F. DAY FOUR (26 MAR 15): IN THE MORNING, EACH WG LEAD WILL BACK BRIEF THE OAG MEMBERS ON THE WAY AHEAD FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE ISSUES. IN THE AFTERNOON, THE OAG VOTING MEMBERS WILL "RACK AND STACK" THE ISSUES FROM EACH WG AND VOTE ON THE PRIORITY TOPICS FOR THE T&D OAG. UPON CONCLUSION, THE OAG DETAILS WILL BE RECORDED AND DISSEMINATED VIA AMHS MSG FROM DC I&L (LPD) AS PART OF THE RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS.
