NARR/(U) THIS GENADMIN PROVIDES USTRANSCOM TRAVEL GUIDANCE TO THE JOINT FORCE REGARDING PERSONNEL BASED ON REF A. THIS GUIDANCE PERTAINS

TO PERSONNEL UTILIZING USTRANSCOM, AIR MOBILITY COMMAND (AMC) MILITARY

OR COMMERCIALLY CONTRACTED MODES OF TRAVEL. THIS GENADMIN CLARIFIES TRANSCOM'S DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENT FOR COVID-19 TEST WAIVERS, AND REINFORCES PROOF OF COVID-19 TEST RESULTS AS SPECIFIED IN REF A.

#### GENTEXT/REMARKS/

1. (U) SITUATION. COVID-19 CONTINUES TO PRESENT A SIGNIFICANT RISK TO

TRAVEL WORLDWIDE. REF A PROMULGATES NEW REQUIREMENTS TO MINIMIZE THE SPREAD OF COVID-19; SPECIFICALLY, REF A REQUIRES HOME STATION TESTING FOR COVID-19 PRIOR TO INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL.

## 2. (U) TESTING GUIDANCE

2.A. (U) EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, PER REF A, PRIOR TO INITIATING INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL ALL PERSONNEL (MILITARY AND CIVILIAN) UTILIZING USTRANSCOM MILITARY AND COMMERCIAL AIRCRAFT SHALL HAVE PROOF OF A NEGATIVE COVID-19 VIRAL TEST TAKEN 1-3 DAYS PRIOR TO DEPARTING HOME STATION. BEGINNING 15 JANUARY 2021, USTRANSCOM WILL DENY BOARDING TO TRAVELERS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH REF A.

- 2.A.1. (U) ALL TESTING WILL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH REF A. THE MOLECULAR TEST IS THE PREFERRED TESTING METHODOLOGY. HOWEVER, AN ANTIGEN TEST MAY BE USED WHEN A MOLECULAR TEST IS NOT AVAILABLE.

  2.A.2. (U) REGARDLESS OF THE MANUFACTURER, OR NUMBER OF DOSES, THE COVID-19 VACCINE DOES NOT EXEMPT A TRAVELER FROM COMPLYING WITH REF A.
- 2.B. (U) DESTINATION COUNTRY TESTING REQUIREMENTS MAY EXCEED DOD REQUIREMENTS. TRAVELERS WILL ADHERE TO THE MOST STRINGENT REQUIREMENT. FORCE PROVIDERS AND TRAVELERS WILL ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH DESTINATION COUNTRY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO INITIATING TRAVEL.
- 2.B.1. (U) REF B, THE FOREIGN CLEARANCE GUIDE (FCG), IS THE GOVERNING DOCUMENT FOR COUNTRY CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS.
- 2.B.2. (U) ORGANIZATIONS THAT IDENTIFY DISCREPANCIES OR CONFLICTS IN THE FCG SHOULD NOTIFY THE FCG POINT OF CONTACT (POC). TO PROVIDE UPDATES, E-MAIL THE FCG POC AT <u>DOD.FCP@US.AF.MIL</u> OR SIPR: <u>USAF.FCG@MAIL.SMIL.MIL</u>. UPDATE SUGGESTIONS MUST INCLUDE THE CURRENT DOD FCG REQUIREMENT AND DETAIL THE PROPOSED CHANGE. UTILIZE TEXT EDIT TOOLS (STRIKETHROUGH, RED FONT OR YELLOW HIGHLIGHT) TO EASE IDENTIFICATION.

- 2.C. (U) IN ADDITION TO THE FCG, TRAVELERS AND FORCE PROVIDERS MUST ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH ANY TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS COMMUNICATED BY COMBATANT COMMANDERS (OPORDS, EXORDS, ETC.) OR THE RECEIVING COMMAND.
- 3. (U) PROOF OF A NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST.
- 3.A. (U) ALL TRAVELERS ON OFFICIAL OVERSEAS ORDERS WILL ARRIVE AT THE TERMINAL WITH HARDCOPY PROOF OF A NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST CONDUCTED WITHIN THREE DAYS PRIOR TO DEPARTING HOME STATION UNLESS THE HOST NATION SPECIFIES A TYPE OF TEST OR TESTING TIMELINE. A NOTE FROM A DOCTOR WILL NOT MEET THIS REQUIREMENT.
- 3.A.1. A POLYMERASE CHAIN REACTION (PCR) TEST IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR TRAVELERS DIAGNOSED WITH AND RECOVERED FROM COVID-19 AND WHO REMAIN ASYMPTOMATIC WITHIN 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF INITIAL SYMPTOM ONSET. 3.A.2. TRAVELERS DIAGNOSED AS COVID-19 POSITIVE AND HAVE RECOVERED REQUIRE MEDICAL CLEARANCE DOCUMENTATION WITHIN 90 DAYS PRIOR TO OFFICIAL OVERSEAS MOVEMENT.
- 3.A.3. (U) USTRANSCOM WILL VERIFY NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST DOCUMENTATION

PRIOR TO BOARDING PATRIOT EXPRESS FLIGHTS.

- 4. (U) WAIVING PRE-TRAVEL TESTING.
- 4.A. IAW REF A, PRIOR TO TRAVEL, MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO COMPLETE THE REQUIRED COVID-19 TEST; HOWEVER, PRE-TRAVEL TESTING MAY BE WAIVED IF TESTING IS UNAVAILABLE. COORDINATE THE WAIVER WITH THE RECEIVING COMMAND.
- 4.A.1 (U) IAW REF A, AUTHORITY TO WAIVE PRE-TRAVEL TESTING MAY BE DELEGATED IN WRITING TO A LEVEL NO LOWER THAN AN APPROPRIATE OFFICER IN THE GRADE OF O-6 OR A CIVILIAN EQUIVALENT IN THE TRAVELER'S CHAIN OF COMMAND OR, FOR CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEES, AN O-6 OR CIVILIAN EQUIVALENT
- IN THE PROGRAM OFFICE OR REQUIRING ACTIVITY.
- 4.B. (U) USTRANSCOM WILL REQUIRE TRAVELERS WITH A WAIVER TO PRESENT DOCUMENTATION WHEN REQUESTED. WAIVING AUTHORITY WILL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 4.B.1. (U) WAIVING AUTHORITY WILL CERTIFY AN INABILITY TO PROVIDE OR ARRANGE A COVID-19 TEST FOR THE TRAVELER WITHIN THREE DAYS OF DEPARTURE.
- 4.B.2. (U) WAIVING AUTHORITY WILL CERTIFY THEY HAVE COORDINATED WITH THE RECEIVING COMMAND.
- 4.B.2.A. (U) WAIVING AUTHORITY WILL CERTIFY THE GAINING COMMAND HAS STATED THEY WILL TO ACCEPT THE TRAVELER WITHOUT A COVID-19 TEST.
  4.B.2.B. (U) WAIVING AUTHORITY WILL IDENTIFY THE POINT OF CONTACT AT THE RECEIVING COMMAND THROUGH WHICH THEY MADE COORDINATION.
  4.B.3. (U) TO SUPPORT USTRANSCOM'S EFFORTS, WAIVING AUTHORITY WILL NOTIFY USTRANSCOM AT NIPR: TRANSCOM.SCOTT.TCJ3.MBX.COVID19-OPG@MAIL.MIL AND AMC AT AMC.A3X.OPS@US.AF.MIL, WHEN THE WAIVER IS SIGNED. THE NOTIFICATION WILL INCLUDE THE TRAVELERS NAME AND FLIGHT INFORMATION.
- 5. (U) GUIDANCE TO THE JOINT FORCE FOR THOSE NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH REF A, B, OR C.
- 5.A. (U) FAILURE OF FORCE PROVIDERS AND TRAVELERS TO DETERMINE DESTINATION COUNTRY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO ENTRY MAY RESULT IN DENIAL OF BOARDING ON USTRANSCOM AIRCRAFT.
- 5.B. (U) USTRANSCOM DOES NOT PROVIDE DISPOSITION OR ACCOMMODATION(S) FOR TRAVELERS UNABLE TO TRAVEL FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS IN REF A.
